## Year 1 Mrs Day and Mr Mason

### English / Literacy

Stories linked to our topic - Enchanted Lives  
Instructional writing linked to writing across the curriculum e.g. Knowledge and Understanding of the World and Religious Education. Reading skills will be developed through weekly Guided Group Reading. Oracy skills will be developed through English and across the curriculum. Weekly spelling/sound rules, high frequency and CVCC words taught and practiced through Read Write Inc.

## Term: Autumn 2018

### Maths

Number Skills - Reading, writing and ordering numbers, odd and even numbers, 1 more/1 less. Addition and Subtraction. Shape. Various problem solving tasks based on the topics studied.

### RE / Values Thankfulness and Trust

**Bible-** To learn about the stories in the Bible and that it teaches us how to live.

**Festivals** - The festival of Harvest  
Our Prayer Bear will be sent home to each child over the year.

### Topic - Enchanted Lives

- All skills taught in English and Maths will be applied across the curriculum and through our topic wherever possible.
- Knowledge and Understanding of the World - Our topic is 'Enchanted Lives'. Skills will be developed throughout the topic following on from our Immersion day and discussions with the children
- ICT - Our Digital World -, Hwb,
- Creative Development -Physical Development - Developing our fine motor skills using a variety of pieces of equipment and through games. Gymnastic - making different body shapes.
