English / Literacy

This term they will be writing to entertain and persuade. Reading skills will be developed through weekly Guided Group Reading. Weekly spelling rules taught and practiced. Oracy skills developed through English and across the curriculum.

RE / Values Thankfulness and Trust

The Church - Understanding the importance of actions and symbols, understanding the 'family' of the church of wales in many countries.

Festivals - To help the children to appreciate some of the significance of the symbol of 'light' and to make connections between the biblical text and Christian and Jewish Festivals.

Maths

Place value and addition; decimals, addition and money; subtraction; properties of shapes; multiplication, division and fractions; place value and multiplication; multiplication and division; place value, decimals and subtraction; measures; fractions; addition, subtraction and multiplication
Weekly reasoning and problem solving activities.

Develop skills, knowledge and understanding through the theme of 'Healthy Living' through the topic of The Victorians.

- All skills taught in English, Maths and Science will be applied across the curriculum and through the topic of the Victorians wherever possible.
