## English / Literacy

Stories linked to our topic. Explanation and Instruction writing linked to writing across the curriculum e.g. Knowledge and Understanding of the World and Religious Education. Reading skills will be developed through Letters and Sounds and weekly Guided Group Reading. Oracy skills developed through English and across the curriculum.

## Maths

We will be using Numicon to help support our number work. This term we will cover counting to 20 forwards and backwards using songs and rhymes, writing numbers, addition and subtraction, comparing height, weight and distance and 2D/3D shapes.

## RE / Values Perseverance and Justice

To learn about the Christian story in particular focusing on the Creation and know that God is the creator of the universe. To use the term 'Salvation' and that Christians remember Jesus' last week at Easter.

## Topic - Stomp and Roar

- All skills taught in English and Maths will be applied across the curriculum and through our topic wherever possible.
- Knowledge and Understanding of the World - what dinosaurs ate, where they lived and how they died.
- ICT - Digital Literacy and programming
- Creative Development - To use a range of materials and tools to make images, and explore practically and imaginatively visual, tactile and sensory qualities.
- Music - Exploring a variety of different instruments
- Physical Development - Welsh Folk dancing and Dinosaur stomp
- Welsh - Songs and poems linked to Dewi Sant (St. David) and Focusing on Ble? (Where)
- PSD - Developing personal and social skills, alongside independence.

Reading books will be sent home every Tuesday, please ensure you read with your child every day as it increases their literacy skills.
