Term: Summer 2019

English / Literacy

Stories linked to our topic. Writing to Entertain and Writing to Inform writing linked to writing across the curriculum e.g. Humanities, Science and Technology, Health and Well Being and Religious Education. Reading skills will be developed through weekly Guided Group Reading sessions and Read Write Inc Comprehension. Daily phonic sessions through our Read Write Inc. program. Oracy skills developed through Literacy and across the curriculum.

Maths

Number work, rounding, mental strategies for near doubles and adding, bridging through multiples of 10, adding three or more 1-digit numbers, adding/subtracting 2-digit numbers to 100, fractions, capacity, directions and measurement. Weekly Problem solving.

RE / Values

Service and **Truthfulness** are our values for the summer.

Our RE focus this term will be on the Bible. We will be looking at why it is a special book for Christians.

We will also be looking Judaism.

Topic - H2O

All skills taught in English and Maths will be applied across the curriculum and through our topic wherever possible.

- Humanities - Looking at a pirate's life particularly Black Bart, the Welsh Pirate. Oceans around the world, maps and directions.
- Science and Technology - Investigating Plastic Pollution in our oceans and also looking at the water cycle. Also, as part of directions we will be looking at algorithms.
- Expressive Arts - Looking at water colours, designing and making our own pirate ships, singing a range of pirate themed songs with accompanying instruments.
- Health and Well Being - Ball skills, athletics and the affect exercise has on our bodies and how we can stay fit and healthy.
- Welsh - 'Beth wyt ti'n bwyta?' 'Ar lan y môr'.
