Maths

Number facts and relationships using terms multiples and factors, manage money add/subtract totals less than £10, compare costs budgeting. Time digital and analogue. Volume in practical contexts, perpendicular and parallel lines. Movement and reflection of shape. Function machines. Developing reasoning and problem solving skills.

Science

We will be developing skills, knowledge and understanding of this curriculum area through our theme 'World of Water'.

Term: Summer 2019

English / Literacy

Creative writing skills will be developed through Pie Corbett's Talk 4 writing. Further Genres to be developed will include persuasive writing and writing to inform. Reading skills will be developed through weekly Guided Group Reading. Weekly spelling rules taught and practiced. Oracy skills developed through English, Cooperative Learning and across the curriculum.

RE / Values Service and Thankfulness

Children will learn about the Kingdom of God through their study of the Bible. They will also understand the celebration of Jewish festivals.
