## Year 5 - Miss Bush

### English / Literacy

This term children will be writing to entertain. Reading skills will be developed through weekly Guided Group Reading. Weekly spelling rules taught and practiced. Oracy skills developed through English and across the curriculum.

### RE / Values

#### **Service and Truthfulness**

Understanding Christianity - The Big Frieze

Children will continue to learn about Salvation as part of the Christian Story. They will also begin to discover and understand other religions this term.

## Term: Summer 2019

### Maths

**Number skills** - Place value; addition/subtraction; multiplication/division; decimals/fractions and ratio

**Measuring skills**- Area/volume/perimeter; length/weight/mass/capacity; co-ordinates and time.

**Data skills** - Probability; Represent and interpret data using tables and bar charts

Numerical reasoning will be developed through weekly reasoning and problem-solving activities.

### Science

Develop skills, knowledge and understanding through the topic of 'Energy, Light and Sound'.

### Topic - Dizzy Heights (mountains)

All skills taught in English, Maths and Science will be applied across the curriculum and through the topic of Dizzy Heights wherever possible.

- **Music** - Compose music (performance at St David's Hall)
- **PE** - Athletics and team building                      **Games** - Cricket
- **DT** - Design and make a torch
- **Welsh** - Learn and recite a traditional tale and produce their own (Talk for Writing)
- **Art** - Create landscapes using a range of materials (from our trip to Pen y Fan)
- **ICT** - Digital Competence Framework skills will be taught throughout the curriculum
