English / Literacy

Writing to Entertain - Description
Writing to Persuade - Advertising
Writing to Discuss - Newspaper Reports and Discussions

Reading skills will be developed through weekly Guided Group Reading. Weekly spelling rules taught and practiced.

Oracy will be developed through our end of year show entitled 'Let the Games Begin.'

Science

Plan and carry out investigations and develop skills, knowledge and understanding through the theme of 'Water Life'.

Maths

Weekly reasoning and problem solving activities.
Revision and consolidation of previous learning.
