## English / Literacy

Stories linked to our topic. Report writing and recount linked to writing across the curriculum e.g. Knowledge and Understanding of the World and Religious Education. Reading skills will be developed through weekly Guided Group Reading. Daily Read, Write, Inc lessons to develop children's reading and spelling skills. Oracy skills developed through English and across the curriculum.

## Maths

Number facts and counting, time, length, position and direction, place value, doubling, halving, addition and subtraction, 2D shape and data. Weekly reasoning and problem solving activities.

## RE / Values **Courage & Forgiveness**

**Christian life and Values**- The importance of truth, honesty and forgiveness to Christians.

**Festivals** - To understand that Christian festivals are celebrations of important and happy events - linked to Easter.

**The Church** - To know the church is a family and that each member has a different role.

## Topic - It's cold Outside

- All skills taught in English and Maths will be applied across the curriculum and through our topic wherever possible.
- Knowledge and Understanding of the World - learning about animals and their habitats. Learning about the geography of different places and comparing it to Wales. Looking at the history surrounding the Arctic and Antarctic.
- ICT - Data Handling & Programming
- Creative Development - To use a range of materials and tools to make images and artefacts, and explore practically and imaginatively visual, tactile and sensory qualities.
- Physical Development - Gymnastic skills to perform a floor sequence.
