## Year 5 Miss Case

### English / Literacy

They will be writing information reports and recounts. The class will also be developing their poetic style and as well as learning stories from other cultures. Reading skills will be developed through weekly Guided Group Reading. Weekly spelling rules taught and practiced. Oracy skills developed through English and across the curriculum.

### Science

Develop skills, knowledge and understanding through the theme of 'Water Life' through the topic Land Down Under (Australia).

### Maths

Place value, addition and subtraction, place value and addition, co-ordinates and line graphs, multiplication and division, fractions and decimals, multiplication and division, place value and subtraction, perimeter area and volume, number and place value and addition and place value. Weekly reasoning and problem solving activities.
