Maths

Number facts and relationships using terms multiples and factors, manage money add/subtract totals less than £10, compare costs budgeting. Time digital and analogue. Volume in practical contexts, perpendicular and parallel lines. Movement and reflection of shape. Function machines. Developing reasoning and problem solving skills.

Science

We will be developing skills, knowledge and understanding of this curriculum area through our topic.

Term: Summer 2018

English / Literacy

Creative writing skills will be developed through Pie Corbett's Talk 4 writing. Further Genres to be developed will include persuasive and discussion writing. Reading skills will be developed through weekly Guided Group Reading. Weekly spelling rules taught and practiced. Oracy skills developed through English, Cooperative Learning and across the curriculum.

RE / Values Service, Respect and Reverence

Christian Lives and Values - Children will learn Christian events and traditions. They will be introduced to the role of the Church. They will work from a Bible and comprehend the reality of journeys made by Jesus. They will also understand the celebration of Jewish festivals.
